

FAQ Erasmus Incoming – Course choices during the mobility

Can I change my Learning Agreement after the arrival?

Yes, changes to the Learning Agreement can be done within the first 6 weeks of your stay. Those changes are **compulsory** in case you want the course to be listed on your transcript of records at the end of your stay. If you do not change your Learning Agreement, you won't see the course on the transcript.

When you recognize that you can't join into some lectures (e.g. because the course is full or your schedule is blocked during the time) you have to delete it or try to find another course, where you can join/participate.

Is it guaranteed that I can participate at the courses that I listed in my "Learning Agreement before the mobility"?

No. We can only guarantee main subject lessons in advance. If you chose electives which are taught in one-to-one-lessons (e.g. minor subject piano) the capacity will be checked prior to your arrival. In case of group lectures, please ask the teacher whether he or she can offer you a place.

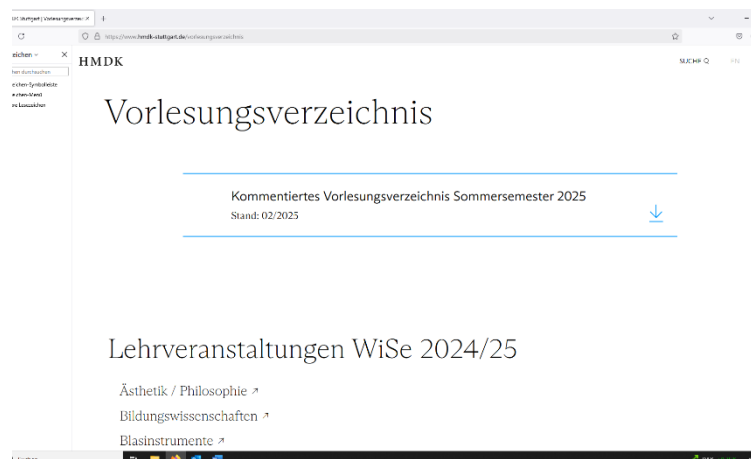
Where do I find electives?

When you found a course, which you are interested in, please write a mail to the course teacher and ask if you can participate.

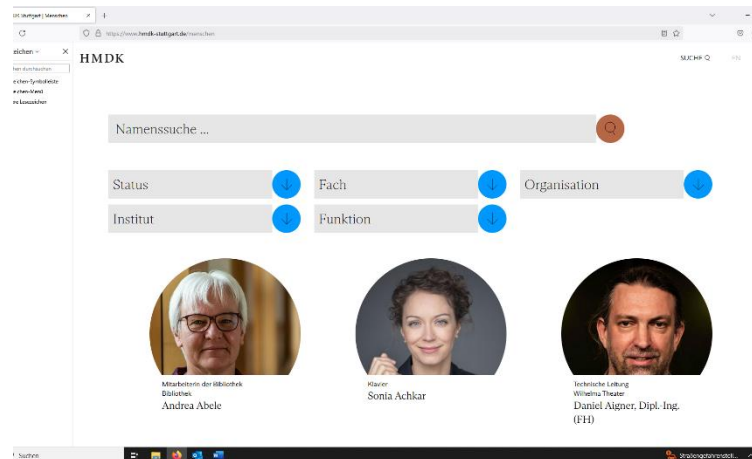
Where do I find the course catalogue?
